

SCAQ Professional Pathways Program Subscription

Terms and Conditions

Date: 16 July 2026

1. Purpose

This policy exists to guide SCAQ staff, Committee Members, Board Members, SCAQ Members and employees of SCAQ Members on the use and conditions for use of the SCAQ Professional Pathways Program subscription.

The following terms and conditions are applicable to all products covered under the SCAQ Professional Pathways Program subscription.

2. SCAQ Professional Pathways Program subscription

The SCAQ Professional Pathways Program subscription includes all live SCAQ CPD webinars and On Demand SCAQ CPD Webinars through the Education Platform.

From January 2027 it also includes **access to onsite face-to-face CPD training** delivered by SCAQ Affiliated Trainers (*where trainers are available in Qld and subject to booking availability*).

3. Purchasing the Professional Pathways Program subscription

Corporate members can purchase the SCAQ Professional Pathways Program subscription with their membership renewal. The cost of the package is for a 12-month period and is based on the number of lots under management as of 30th June each year.

Corporate members can also purchase the SCAQ Professional Pathways Program subscription throughout the year. The cost of the package is based on the number of lots under management at the time the application is made..

4. Inclusiveness

The SCAQ Professional Pathways Program subscription is available to all employees of the purchasing Corporate SCAQ member. The registrant is not required to be a member of SCAQ if the corporate entity is a member of SCAQ and has purchased the SCAQ Professional Pathways Program subscription, however confirmation that they are an employee of the corporate member will be required at the time of registration.

In addition to the live webinars, access is also available to the Education Platform enabling employees of the corporate member to download and view SCAQ CPD webinars On Demand.

5. Exclusions

The SCAQ Professional Pathways Program subscription excludes the following:

- A100
- Strata Starter - BCM
- Strata Starter - Services
- Master Class

- Law Forum
- QStrata
- Any other educational offering or event hosted by SCAQ other than CPD webinars.
- On Demand content provided by other States or SCA National

However participating firms of the SCAQ Professional Pathways Program will receive a **10% discount** on eligible face-to-face education events, including QStrata, Masterclasses and Symposiums.

6. Privacy

Privacy: SCAQ does not disclose your name or contact information to third parties. All information collected is used for SCAQ purposes only.

SCAQ takes reasonable steps to ensure your personal information is not exposed to misuse, loss, or unauthorised access.

7. Payment terms

The payment policy applies to all members of SCAQ. SCAQ's standard payment terms are 14 days, unless otherwise stated.

8. Program disclaimer:

Where a program has been released, SCAQ reserves the right to alter, amend, vary, or otherwise change the program at any time as circumstances dictate without further notice to registered delegates. Every effort will be made to provide a program of equivalent standard and value.

9. Registration

Live Webinars: Unless your company has an SCAQ Professional Pathways Program subscription, screen sharing, and link sharing is NOT permitted.

SCAQ is electronically advised every time a Zoom/Teams link is shared and with whom.

- SCAQ reserves the right to invoice additional attendees, post webinar, if the link has been shared to individuals that were not registered to attend and are not on the SCAQ Professional Pathways Program subscription.
- If you are an employee of an SCAQ Corporate Member who has purchased the SCAQ Professional Pathways Program subscription, you can access the live webinars and SCAQ On Demand webinars for FREE.
- If the registrant is an employee of a Corporate Member and the Corporate Member has not purchased the SCAQ Professional Pathways Program subscription, they will be charged per CPD webinar.
- If the registrant is not a member of SCAQ, they will be charged the current per CPD webinar price.
- IMPORTANT:** Where the corporate has purchased the Professional Pathways Program subscription and SCAQ members have attended via screen sharing, please email education.qld@strata.community within 7 days of the live webinar for CPD point allocation.

On Demand: SCAQ Corporate Members that have paid for the SCAQ Professional Pathways Program subscription will be provided with a code to access the SCAQ On Demand Webinars on

the Education Platform free of charge. The administrator of the Company will be responsible for advising their current employees of the code.

SCAQ is electronically advised every time On Demand Content is accessed.

SCAQ reserves the right to invoice registrants of the On Demand Content, if the code has been:

- a. shared to individuals that are not on the SCAQ Professional Pathways Program subscription as per 'g' above.
- b. used by individuals that are no longer employees of the company with the SCAQ Professional Pathways Program subscription.
- c. incorrectly applied to content that is excluded from the SCAQ Professional Pathways Program subscription. As per item '5' above.

Fees that will be incurred for incorrect use of the code:

- a. If you are an employee of an SCAQ Corporate Member who has purchased the SCAQ Professional Pathways Program subscription, you can access the SCAQ live webinars and SCAQ On Demand webinars for FREE.
- b. If the registrant is an employee of a Corporate Member and the Corporate Member has not purchased the SCAQ Professional Pathways Program subscription, they will be charged the current per CPD webinar price.
- c. If the registrant is not a member of SCAQ, they will be the current per CPD webinar price.
